




1.) Plausibilität:

Der RC Beirut Cedars möchte folgende Filtrationseinheiten verschiedener Größe anschaffen, um Trinkwasser bereitzuhalten.

Displaces sind in den Schulen, kommunalen Gebäuden – Hygiene muss gewährleistet sein. Krankheitvermeidung – Seuchenvermeidung.

Wissenswert: Durch mangelnden Umweltschutz sind die Flüsse schmutzig, derzeit arbeitet eine Gruppe an der Säuberung des Litani-Flusses, natürlich momentan nur theoretische Basisarbeit. Das Grundwasser ist durch Überdüngung in der Bekaa-Ebene belastet.

Grant Number: GG2466962

Project Overview: The "Clean Water for Communities" project aims to address critical water sanitation and hygiene needs in Lebanon, specifically targeting underserved communities in the North Governorate and Mount Lebanon Governorate. Despite Lebanon's rich water resources, the failure of governmental infrastructure has resulted in widespread access to unsafe drinking water, contributing to numerous water-borne diseases.



This project will provide sustainable access to clean and safe drinking water, improving public health outcomes and the quality of life for thousands of residents. It builds on a previous district grant that provided solutions and training for personnel, ensuring the sustainability of the project.

Main Objectives:

- **Supply Safe Drinking Water:** Install SkyHydrant water filtration systems to ensure access to clean and safe drinking water for communities currently relying on contaminated water sources.
- **Improve Health and Sanitation:** Reduce the incidence of water-borne diseases by providing purified water, thereby enhancing public health.
- **Ensure Sustainability:** Train local personnel and municipal engineering teams to operate and maintain the filtration systems, ensuring the long-term reliability of the water supply.

Target Beneficiaries: The project is expected to benefit approximately 40,000 people across multiple locations. Beneficiaries include households, schools, and healthcare facilities, with a particular focus on vulnerable groups such as women and children in remote areas.

Collaborative Approach: This project is a collaboration between multiple Rotary clubs, both local and international, along with local municipalities, and international partners like the SkyJuice™ Foundation. By leveraging the expertise and resources of these partners, the project aims to ensure a sustainable impact on water quality and public health in Lebanon.

Budget Overview: The total budget for the project is estimated at \$132,500 USD. Funding sources include contributions from participating Rotary clubs, district-designated funds, and the Rotary Foundation World Fund.

Call to Action: We invite Rotary clubs and districts worldwide to join us in this impactful initiative. Your support will not only help provide a basic human need—clean water—but also promote peace, health, and prosperity in a region facing significant challenges.


